

Cruise Port Medemblik HARBOUR FACILITIES

Cruise Port Medemblik is part of Stadshavens Medemblik. The harbour lies on the west side of the IJsselmeer - between Enkhuizen and Den Helder – and therefore enjoys a wonderful logistical position on the sailing route to Wadden island Texel.

Stadshavens Medemblik offers river cruise ships a nicely lit mooring jetty in the centre of the town. From the jetty, passengers can walk directly to the lively town centre and enjoy many worthwhile places, shops, restaurants and cafés. The moored cruise ships are easily accessible.

The area around the jetty offers a safe place for passengers to hop on and hop off the City Tours tourist train, the horse tram or to other transport means and to explore the lovely environment.

At the edge of the centre, near the exit roads, is a spacious car park where vehicles can be parked for free. Cruise Port Medemblik also has a professional and hospitable port service, which is always pleased to assist you. The mooring jetty has clean and waste water facilities. Wadden island Texel, as well as impressive harbours, such as, Amsterdam, Enkhuizen, Hoorn, Lelystad, Lemmer and Hanzesteden Kampen and Zwolle, are reachable at a short sailing distance. The compact character of the lively centre, the warm hospitality of the residents and the attractive selection of excursions make Cruise Port Medemblik a lovely and comfortable place for disembarking!

THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION

Hop on the City Tours train and take a unique tour along many of the special highlights of Medemblik. It lets you off at the Nederlands Stoommachinemuseum, which is located in the former pumping station called Vier Noorder Koggen, dating back to 1869. In the museum you will encounter the largest collection of working pumping machines in the Netherlands.

Step into the fascinating world of steam and during the 1.5 hour tour, discover how the invention of James Watts works and the power of water and fire. A lovely image of the times.

RADBOUD CASTLE

BACK TO MEDIEVAL TIMES

In the thirteen century, Duke Floris V commissioned the construction of a fortress on the shores of the Zuiderzee. The Radboud Castle enabled him to have control over the inhabitants of Medemblik and to be able to defend the region against the threat of the Frisians from the other side of the Zuiderzee.

Take a lovely walk through historic Medemblik and visit the centuries-old fortress. During the approx. 1.5 hour audio tour, you will hear everything about the dark Middle Ages and discover the dark passageways, tower chambers and the dungeons in this ancient castle.

STEAM TRAM MUSEUM

A CENTURIES-OLD STATION

The railway from 1887 between Hoorn and Medemblik is unique in its completeness. Many old station buildings and bridges from long ago have been preserved. That also applies to the station of Medemblik. The platforms and the station environment have been entirely preserved to look and function as they did in the past. The station, located directly next to the mooring jetty, is open around the arrival and departure times of the Steam Tram Museum and welcomes visitors. Go back in time and take a look at the waiting room, the office and the station master, and the sheds for the transport of goods. The railway is part of the Historic Triangle of Enkhuizen-Medemblik-Hoorn.

THAT'S HOW THE VANES SPIN

For centuries windmills were the face of harbour town of Medemblik. They constituted an important link in the provision of food. Choosing to visit De Herder flour mill is first a lovely walk on the dyke and then entering through the nearly Gatehouse.

Here you can see a continuous slide show about the monumental Westfriese Omringdijk and the history of the windmills. The tour through the flour mill, with an explanation of how it works and its technique, makes your excursion completet.

VISIT INCLUDING TOUR

The Bonifacius Church from 1400 has a beautiful traditional interior. The organ was made by the famous organ builder Pieter Backer. A special feature is the organ rack made from pear wood, which comes from the original organ.

The church has tombstones dating back to the Golden Age, including the headstone of Lord Murray, the Scottish captain of the last independence war against England.



DISCOVER RURAL MEDEMBLIK

Take a lovely horse tram trip though rural and discover the West Frisian local products!

Travel at a slow pace along the vast meadows, lines of houses close to the road and the historic villages of Twisk and Opperdoes. You will visit Hero Stam where you will be introduced to the world famous local product: 'De Opperdoezer Ronde' potatoes.

The horse tram is covered and closed so that you stay dry and comfortable in case of unforeseen rain or wind. On a day with sunshine, the cover of the tram is opened.

DE KOGGEVAARDER

UNIQUE TOUR IN AN OPEN BOAT

Navigate through the historic 16th century of Medemblik. Via the Overleker Canal – the connection between the Wieringer Lake and the IJssel Lake – you arrive at Westersluis. This lock ensures that the differentiating water levels can easily be navigated. Afterwards you sail in the direction of Kleine Vliet. You listen to the story about the old pumping station, De Vier Noorder Koggen, where the Dutch Steam Engine Museum is now located and which has a working pumping machine from 1869.

Finally, via Vlietstroom you sail along the former Royal Naval Institute Landswerf from 1799, which was once honoured with a visit by Napoleon.

MEDEMBLIK Rich in Stories

As the oldest town in West Friesland, Medemblik is armed with a rich history that goes back to Medieval times. As early as 1289, Medemblik was the first place in West Friesland to be granted the rights of a city. In the same period, Duke Floris V had a fortress built, now known as Radboud Castle.

Through the centuries, the harbour town has been plagued by plundering, a big town fire (1555) and sieges. During the Golden Age, Medemblik enjoyed exuberant growth. An important factor in this development was the trade in Scandinavian wood. The many 17th century facades in the historical town centre are evidence of this expansion. When the North Holland canal was opened in 1824, the connection of the Zuiderzee with the Afsluitdijk and the establishment of the Wieringermeer polder immensely boosted the significance of Medemblik as a harbour town.



During the 1960s, the town established it highlights and developed into an internationally renown water sport centre.

Nowadays, Medemblik is known as a lively IJsselmeer town with beautiful harbours and a compact and attractive town centre.

WORTHWHILE SIGHTS

Medemblik has more than 80 listed monuments. The town hall was built in 1939 (architect A.J. Krop-Holler). There is also a working grain windmill (De Herder, renovated in 1990) and in the former pumping station, Vier Noorder Koggen, is located in the Dutch Steam Machine Museum.Located at Westerhaven (harbour) is the magnificent building 's Landswerf. An interesting bit of information about this place is that on 15 October 1811, Napoleon visited the former Royal Navy Institute in order to inspect 4 armed ships ready to sail. He ate his lunch in the Waterschapshuis on the other side of the harbour. Since 1887, Medemblik has a rail link to Hoorn. The station building, located directly at the mooring jetty, dates back to this period. Nowadays, this rail link is used by the Hoorn-Medemblik Steam Tram Museum.

TODAY

Medemblik is valued for its combination of water, nature and history. While in early days the water was a threat and the risk of a breach in the dyke was a constant threat, it is now an inexhaustible source of pleasure and natural beauty.

The town and its surroundings offer plenty of space for recreation and relaxation. The many harbours, holiday parks and camping sites make Medemblik an adored holiday destination. During the summer months, countless events add a lively décor to the town.

The residents of Medemblik are known for their engaged 'village-like' manners: everyone greets each other on the street and visitors are welcomed with warm hospitality.

Medemblik is a wonderful base for visits to Amsterdam (50 minutes by car), the Afsluitdijk (25 minutes by car), Friesland (45 minutes by car) or the nearby tulip fields in the Wieringermeer polder – the only 'real' Zuiderzee polder in the Netherlands.
